Re: Primary 3 Assessment 2024

We would like to provide an update on the weighted assessments in Term 2.

Assessment Weighting for 2024

Information on the assessment weighting in 2024 for Primary 3 is provided in the table below.

For these weighted assessments, there will not be a standardised day for the level to complete the holistic assessment. The teachers may carry out the tasks on any day in the stipulated week, taking into consideration the class' schedule for other learning activities such as learning journeys, spelling and school celebrations. It is our hope that students will gradually develop intrinsic motivation for learning as they focus on their own learning pace and seek improvement from the teachers' feedback.

Only Medical Certificates and other valid official documents are accepted for absences from Weighted Assessments (WA) and End-of-Year Examination (EYE). Kindly note that letters from parents will not be accepted and there will be no make-up assessment for absentees. Marks will not be awarded for absentees without valid documents.

If your child is absent for an assessment, his/her subject teacher will pass the assessment paper to him/her for practice. It will **not** be counted as a weighted assessment. Marks will be pro-rated for students who submit their medical certificate (MC). No mark will be given for students who are absent without a reason deemed valid by the school.
