Dear Parents,

Re: 2024 Primary 4 Calendar of Events for Term 2

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 4 level in Term 2.

1. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays or Thursdays, after school hours. In **Term 2 Week 1**, CCAs start on either **19 Mar (Tue)** or **21 Mar (Thu)**, depending on the CCA. More information will be provided to students by their CCA teachers.

2. Enrichment and Remedial Programme (ERP)

The P4 ERP is conducted for **selected students** after school hours from **Term 2 Week 1**. Consent forms have been issued to the selected students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programme. Details are listed in the table below.

3. Primary 4 Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC)

The Primary 4 PCTC will be held in **Term 2 Week 10**, on **21 May (Tue)** and **23 May (Thu)**. PCTC is an opportunity for parents, students and teachers to interact and dialogue about the student's progress through the course of Semester 1. More details about the PCTC will be made available at a later date.

4. Subject-based Banding (SBB) for Primary 4 Students

All Primary 4 students will be going through SBB at the end of the academic year. SBB provides greater flexibility for your child by offering them the option of a combination of Standard and Foundation subjects, depending on their strengths. This will allow your child to focus on and stretch their potential in subjects they are strong in while building up the fundamentals in the subjects that they need more support. Should you require more details on SBB, you may refer to the *Connect@MPS* presentation slides found on Student Learning Space (SLS). We will be conducting an SBB Briefing for parents on **5 Aug (Mon)**. More details about this event will be made available nearer the date.

5. International Friendship Day

The school will be commemorating International Friendship Day (IFD) on **1 Apr (Mon)**. The IFD theme is Singapore in Asia. International cooperation remains key in our complex world. Asia is the world's fastest-growing region, and Singapore continues to facilitate closer economic, political, social, and cultural cooperation within ASEAN and in Asia. By recognising the importance of connectedness between our neighbouring countries, our youth can play an active role in fostering people-to-people ties, and thus celebrate the region's diversity and vibrancy and promote the spirit of friendship and collaboration. In addition, students can deepen their understanding of Singapore's realities as a small state and appreciate how we can safeguard our national interest and have much to contribute to efforts at international cooperation.

All students will come to school in their school uniform or PE attire as per normal. Various programmes will be planned for the students to help them learn about and appreciate other cultures in our cosmopolitan Singapore.

6. Green Citizenship @ MPS - Earth Week

As a prelude to Earth Day, the school will be commemorating Earth Week from **15 Apr (Mon)** to **19 Apr (Fri)**. In alignment with the 2024 Earth Day theme, Planet vs. Plastics, Green Citizenship @ MPS programmes will be planned for the students to promote sustainable environmental actions that protect the environment, learn more about sustainability and be aware of how their actions impact the environment. By providing our Marsilians with the knowledge and skills to be active green citizens and fostering a sense of agency over environmental issues, we hope to nurture tomorrow's environmental leaders.

7. Revision of Class Timetable


