Re: 2024 Primary 2 Calendar of Events for Term 3

1. Revision of Class Timetable

2. Personal Grooming and Attire

The school will be conducting the Mother Tongue Language Fortnight from **Term 3 Week 2 to Term 3 Week 3**. This annual event is dedicated to creating a conducive environment for promoting the use and learning of Mother Tongue Languages beyond the classroom and school setting. This year's theme is "Language of the Heart, Connecting with our Culture". Through a variety of engaging activities related to the different Mother Tongue Languages, we aim to deepen our students' appreciation of their cultural heritage, foster a greater sense of identity, and cultivate cross-cultural literacy.

4. Racial Harmony Day (RHD)

Racial Harmony Day will be commemorated in **Term 3 Week 4**. This year's theme, "Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic", focuses on the appreciation of the diverse races and religions that make up our multicultural society, and contribute to our shared sense of cohesion and harmony. Students will be exposed to a variety of activities to deepen their appreciation of their culture. They will also learn how the various ethnic groups can play a part to protect our common space and strengthen trust and friendships amongst communities where the experiences of every individual matter and add to our diversity.

5. Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM)@MPS

STEAM@MPS week will be held in **Term 3 Week 5**. Through exploration, STEAM@MPS aims to spark invention, innovation, joy of learning and to enthuse students about STEAM. This year, students will continue to explore STEAM in the field of Art, Music and Physical Education and learn about the opportunities and challenges that is afforded by new technologies through engaging in-class lessons, recess activities and assembly programmes.

6. Primary 2 Parent Workshop

As part of our continuous efforts to engage our stakeholders and to give parents a better understanding of your child's educational journey, the school will be conducting a parent workshop on Mathematics for Primary 2 parents on **Fri, 2 Aug**. Parents will learn about model drawing, an essential and powerful strategy which allow students to draw and visualise mathematical concepts to solve word problems. Our Parent Support Group (PSG) will also be sharing with parents on how communicating with your children in their primary love language helps you to express your love in a way that is more meaningful to them.
