Dear Parents,

Re: 2024 Primary 5 Calendar of Events for Term 3

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 5 level in Term 3.

1. Revision of Class Timetable

Your child would have received a new class timetable for Term 3 and it will take effect from **25 Jun (Tue)** onwards. Kindly note that the change in timetable was to accommodate student programmes and staff movements.

2. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays or Thursdays, after school hours. In **Term 3 Week 1**, CCAs starts on either **25 Jun (Tue)** or **27 Jun (Thu)**, depending on the CCA. More information have been provided to students by their CCA teachers.

3. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)

The P5 ERP is conducted for **selected students*** after school hours starting from **Term 3 Week 1**. It aims to reinforce concepts and skills taught, extend student learning and/or bridge learning gaps, and equip students with subject-specific examination techniques. Consent forms are issued to these students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programme. Details are listed in the table below.

4. National Education (NE) Show for P5 Students

All Primary 5 students will be attending the NE Show at the Padang on **29 Jun (Sat)** from 3pm to around 10pm. The NE Show has been organised to instil a sense of pride and belonging in our students and to bring across the significance of our National Day. Primary 5 students will learn to develop group spirit with their peers and commitment to the community and nation. More details of the programme will be provided at a later date.

5. Primary 5 Outdoor Adventure Camp

Using the outdoors as the classroom for learning and development, the school has organised an Adventure Camp which aims to offer Primary 5 students a unique opportunity to work together as a small team and to overcome various outdoor challenges. The residential camp will be conducted at the **MOE Labrador Outdoor Adventure Centre** from **1 Aug (Thu)** to **3 Aug (Sat)**. More details of the programme will be provided at a later date.

6. Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight

The school will be conducting the Mother Tongue Language Fortnight from **Term 3 Week 2** to **Term 3 Week 3**. This annual event is dedicated to creating a conducive environment for promoting the use and learning of Mother Tongue Languages beyond the classroom and school setting. This year's theme is "Language of the Heart, Connecting with our Culture". Through a variety of engaging activities related to the different Mother Tongue Languages, we aim to deepen our students' appreciation of their cultural heritage, foster a greater sense of identity, and cultivate cross-cultural literacy.

7. Racial Harmony Day (RHD)

Racial Harmony Day will be commemorated in **Term 3 Week 4**. This year's theme, "Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic", focuses on the appreciation of the diverse races and religions that make up our multicultural society, and contribute to our shared sense of cohesion and harmony. Students will be exposed to a variety of activities to deepen their appreciation of their culture. They will also learn how the various ethnic groups can play a part to protect our common space and strengthen trust and friendships amongst communities where the experiences of every individual matter and add to our diversity.

8. Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM)@MPS

STEAM@MPS week will be held in **Term 3 Week 5**. Through exploration, STEAM@MPS aims to spark invention, innovation, joy of learning and to enthuse students about STEAM. This year, students will continue to explore STEAM in the field of Art, Music and Physical Education and learn about the opportunities and challenges that is afforded by new technologies through engaging in-class lessons, recess activities and assembly programmes.
