# Re: 2025 Primary 5 Calendar of Events for Term 3

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 5 level in Term 3.

#### 1. Revision of Class Timetable

Your child would have received a new class timetable for Term 3 and it will take effect from 1 Jul (Tue) onwards. Please note that the change in timetable was to accommodate student programmes and staff movements.

## 2. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays or Thursdays, after school hours. In **Term 3 Week 1**, CCAs starts on either **1 Jul (Tue)** or **3 Jul (Thu)**, depending on the CCA. More information has been provided to students by their CCA teachers.

#### 3. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)

The P5 ERP is conducted for **selected students\*** after school hours starting from **Term 3 Week 1**. It aims to reinforce concepts and skills taught, extend student learning and/or bridge learning gaps, and equip students with subject-specific examination techniques. Consent forms are issued to these students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programme. Details are listed in the table below.

# 4. 2025 Open House and Home-Based Learning (HBL)

#### 5. Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight

The school will conduct the Mother Tongue Language Fortnight in **Term 3 Week 2 and 3**. This annual event is dedicated to creating a conducive environment for promoting the use and learning of Mother Tongue Languages beyond the classroom and school setting. This year's theme is Celebrating Our Roots: Joy in Learning Languages and Pride in Embracing Culture. Through a variety of engaging activities related to the different Mother Tongue Languages, we aim to deepen students' appreciation of their cultural heritage, foster a greater sense of identity, and cultivate cross-cultural literacy.

## 6. National Education (NE) Show for P5 Students

All Primary 5 students will be attending the NE Show at the Padang on **19 Jul (Sat)** from 3pm to around 10pm. The NE Show has been organised to instill a sense of pride and belonging in our students and to bring across the significance of our National Day. Primary 5 students will learn to develop group spirit with their peers and commitment to the community and nation. More details of the programme will be provided at a later date.

#### 7. Racial Harmony Day

Racial Harmony Day will be commemorated in **Term 3 Week 4**. This year's theme "Our People, Our Tapestry" reflects how our diverse cultural identities and traditions are intertwined. Through understanding and respect for all communities, we maintain a strong, unified multicultural society that celebrates our shared heritage. Students will participate in engaging activities to discover and appreciate different cultures. They will also explore how various ethnic groups contribute to protecting our common spaces, strengthening trust and fostering friendships where every individual's experiences enrich our diverse community.

# 8. Personal Grooming and Attire

Marsilians are expected to always be good ambassadors of the school by maintaining a neat and tidy appearance. Having proper attire and grooming also shows readiness for learning. The school will conduct a personal grooming and attire check in **Term 3 Week 5.** Students should refer to the Student Handbook (pg. 19 to 22) for more information on school's expectations for personal grooming and attire.

# 9. Primary 5 Outdoor Adventure Camp

Using the outdoors as the classroom for learning and development, the school has organised an Adventure Camp which aims to offer Primary 5 students a unique opportunity to work together as a small team and to overcome various outdoor challenges. #### 11. National Day

The school will celebrate National Day on **8 Aug (Fri)**. As Singapore marks its 60th year of independence, the theme "Majulah Singapura" celebrates our nation's achievements and resilient spirit. It calls on Singaporeans to face future challenges together while upholding values of trust, inclusivity, and mutual support, encouraging every citizen to play their part in Singapore's continued growth and success. Students will participate in meaningful activities that celebrate Singapore's multicultural heritage and foster friendships among their peers.
