Dear Parents,

**Re: 2025 Primary 6 Calendar of Events for Term 3**

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 6 level in Term 3.

**1. Revision of Class Timetable**

Your child would have received a new class timetable for Term 3 and it will take effect from **1 Jul (Tue)** onwards. Please note that the change in timetable was to accommodate student programmes and staff movements.

**2. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)**

To provide more time and space for the graduating classes to be supported in their PSLE preparation, CCAs will be suspended for all Primary 6 students in Term 3 to help them stay focused.

**3. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)**

The P6 ERP is conducted for **all students** after school hours starting from **Term 3 Week 1**. It aims to reinforce concepts and skills taught, extend student learning and/or bridge learning gaps, and equip students with subject-specific examination techniques. For remedial, consent forms will be issued to selected students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programme. Details are listed in the table below.

#### 4. 2025 Open House and Home-Based Learning (HBL)

The school will be open to the public for our 2025 Open House on **4 Jul (Fri)**. To facilitate the conduct of the Open House, Home-Based Learning (HBL) will be conducted for all Primary 3 to Primary 6 students on that day. Primary 1 and Primary 2 students will continue to have their lessons in school as usual. Please refer to the letter dated 28 May 2025 (Ref No.: MPS/2025/T2/177) for more information.

#### 5. Morning Lectures

For Primary 6 students who come to school early, morning lectures for English Language, Mathematics and Science will be conducted from **7.10am to 7.30am** on Thursdays and Fridays, starting from **Term 3 Week 2**. These bite-sized lectures aim to address common misconceptions and equip students with subject-specific examination skills. Previous cohorts have given positive feedback on how useful these morning lectures had been. More information will be provided by subject teachers.

#### 6. Self-Study Programme (SSP)

To better support **selected** Primary 6 students in their PSLE preparation, the school will be providing a conducive space for self-study after school hours, from the **mid of Term 3** to the **start of Term 4**, prior to the PSLE written examinations. Students can carry out their independent revision or consultation with their subject teachers. More details will be provided at a later date.

#### 7. Direct School Admission (DSA)

Secondary schools will shortlist and select students who have applied to their schools through DSA between **30 Jun** and **4 Sep**. DSA-Sec schools will be conducting **in-person selection for all DSA talent areas for 2025 DSA-Sec**. More details of the interview and selection process can be found on MOE's DSA-Sec website. [<https://www.moe.gov.sg/secondary/dsa/selection>]. Parents are strongly encouraged to inform Form Teachers regarding interview details so that the school can advise accordingly.

#### 8. Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight

The school will conduct the Mother Tongue Language Fortnight in **Term 3 Week 2 and 3**. This annual event is dedicated to creating a conducive environment for promoting the use and learning of Mother Tongue Languages beyond the classroom and school setting. This year's theme is Celebrating Our Roots: Joy in Learning Languages and Pride in Embracing Culture. Through a variety of engaging activities related to the different Mother Tongue Languages, we aim to deepen students' appreciation of their cultural heritage, foster a greater sense of identity, and cultivate cross-cultural literacy.

## 9. Racial Harmony Day

Racial Harmony Day will be commemorated in **Term 3 Week 4**. This year's theme "Our People, Our Tapestry" reflects how our diverse cultural identities and traditions are intertwined. Through understanding and respect for all communities, we maintain a strong, unified multicultural society that celebrates our shared heritage. Students will participate in engaging activities to discover and appreciate different cultures. They will also explore how various ethnic groups contribute to protecting our common spaces, strengthening trust and fostering friendships where every individual's experiences enrich our diverse community.

## 10. Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM)@MPS

STEAM@MPS week will be held in **Term 3 Week 5**. This year, students are invited to explore STEAM through the enchanting world of fairytales. By reimagining classic stories with a STEAM twist, students will foster critical thinking, collaboration, and innovation through engaging in-class lessons, recess activities and assembly programmes, making learning fun and meaningful.

## 11. Personal Grooming and Attire

Marsilians are expected to always be good ambassadors of the school by maintaining a neat and tidy appearance. Having proper attire and grooming also shows readiness for learning. The school will conduct a personal grooming and attire check in **Term 3 Week 5**. Students should refer to the Student Handbook (pg. 19 to 22) for more information on school's expectations for personal grooming and attire.

## 12. National Day

The school will celebrate National Day on **8 Aug (Fri)**. As Singapore marks its 60th year of independence, the theme "Majulah Singapura" celebrates our nation's achievements and resilient spirit. It calls on Singaporeans to face future challenges together while upholding values of trust, inclusivity, and mutual support, encouraging every citizen to play their part in Singapore's continued growth and success. Students will participate in meaningful activities that celebrate Singapore's multicultural heritage and foster friendships among their peers.


