Assessment Policy

Only Medical Certificates and other valid official documents are accepted for absences from Weighted Assessment (WA) and End-of-Year Examination (EYE). Kindly note that letters from parents will not be accepted and there will be no make-up assessment for absentees. Marks will not be awarded for absentees without valid documents.

If your child is absent for an assessment, his/her subject teacher will pass the assessment paper to him/her for practice. It will **not** be counted as a weighted assessment. Marks will be pro-rated for students who submit their medical certificate (MC). A mark of zero will be given for students who are absent without a reason deemed valid by the school.

Non-Weighted Assessment (NWA) for Oral Communication in English Language (EL) and Mother Tongue Language (MTL)

In order to help students to prepare well for PSLE Oral Examination, the school has planned non-weighted Oral Communication practices. Students will have the opportunity to practise this component face-to-face with the examiners. **MTL and EL Oral Communication Practice** will be held after school on **Wednesday, 29 Apr 2026** and **Thursday, 30 Apr 2026** respectively from 2.00p.m. to 4.30p.m. Students will be dismissed immediately after they have completed their practice. Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child on the affected dates.

Please be informed that, in view of the MTL and EL Oral Communication Practices, there will be **no** Primary 6 supplementary classes on **Wednesday, 29 April 2026** and **Thursday, 30 April 2026**.
