Dear Parents,

Re: 2026 Primary 6 Calendar of Events for Term 1

We hope your child has had a good start to 2026 and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 6 level in Term 1.

1. Welcome Back to School (WBS) Gift Pack

As part of our school's WBS programme to "Start Right, Do Right", we would like to warmly welcome our Marsilians back to school at the beginning of the year with a customised homework folder with compartments that will help them stay organised and be responsible in their learning.

2. Developing Marsilians to be Resilient Learners

During Welcome Back to School (WBS) on **6 Jan (Tue)** and **7 Jan (Wed)**, all P6 students engaged in a series of leadership activities aimed at fostering confidence, teamwork, and responsibility. Through the activities, students were able to:

- Be equipped with the skills and knowledge of Stephen Covey's first 3 habits of effective leaders;
- Be equipped with study and notetaking skills in preparation for PSLE and to boost their motivation in achieving their goals;
- Develop the SEL Competency (Responsible Decision-making) and Growth Mindset.

These experiences aimed to empower students to become proactive in their own growth, setting the foundation for a successful and fulfilling school year.

3. Co-curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays during school hours. In **Term 1 Week 4**, CCAs will start on **27 Jan (Tue)**. More information will be provided to students by their CCA teachers.

4. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)

The P6 ERP will be conducted for **all students** after school hours starting from **Term 1 Week 3**. It aims to reinforce concepts and skills taught, extend student learning and/or bridge learning gaps, and equip students with subject-specific examination techniques. 5. Chinese New Year Celebration

On **16 Feb (Mon)**, the school will usher in Chinese New Year with exciting festival activities. All students are to report to school in their school uniform/PE attire by 7.30 am and will be dismissed at 10.30 am. There will be no recess on that day, and canteen will be closed. Please ensure that your child brings along some snacks for *Take 5!*. Do note that **17 Feb (Tue)** and **18 Feb (Wed)** will be public holidays. All students are to report back to school on **19 Feb (Thu)**.

6. Total Defence Day Commemoration

The school will commemorate Total Defence Day (TDD) on **16 Feb (Mon)**. There will be a series of activities in **Term 1 Week 6** to deepen students' understanding of the importance of safeguarding Singapore's security and well-being. Through these learning experiences, students will be introduced to the key pillars of Total Defence, and the roles individuals play in contributing to a safe, resilient, and cohesive society. The activities are designed to reinforce preparedness, resilience, and responsible citizenship, while fostering a shared sense of duty and care among students.

7. *Take 5!*

All students will have a **5-minute break** daily between **12pm** and **12.15pm**. In line with our school's efforts to promote healthy eating, students are encouraged to consume healthy snacks, such as bread, bananas, raisins, cereal bars, whole-grain biscuits or cookies, in class during *Take 5!*.

8. Personal Grooming and Attire Check

Marsilians are expected to always be good ambassadors of the school by maintaining a neat and tidy appearance. Having proper attire and grooming also shows readiness for learning. The school will conduct a personal grooming and attire check in **Term 1 Week 5**. Students should refer to the Student Handbook (pg. 20 to 23) for more information on school's expectations for personal grooming and attire.

9. Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) 2026 for Primary 6

The PTC for the Primary 6 level will be held in **Term 1 Week 10**, on **11 Mar (Wed)** and **12 Mar (Thu)**. It serves as an opportunity for parents and teachers to interact and dialogue about the student's progress through the course of Term 1. Please keep the dates free so that you can make an appointment with the form/ subject teachers. More details about the PTC will be made available at a later date.

10. Photo-taking for the School SMART Card (SSC)

The Ministry of Education will be conducting the yearly photo-taking exercise for all P6 students on **27 Jan (Tue)** for the issuance of the School Smart Card (SSC). The photo-images captured will be used for the printing of Secondary SSCs when they are promoted to Secondary One in 2027. Please ensure that your child wears his/her school uniform and is neat in appearance for the photo-taking session.
