Dear Parents,

Re: 2026 Primary 4 Calendar of Events for Term 2

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participating in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 4 level in Term 2.

1. Revision of Class Timetable

Your child would have received a new class timetable for **Term 2**, and it will take effect in **Week 2** on **30 Mar (Mon)**. Please note that the change in timetable is to accommodate student programmes and staff movements.

2. Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays during school hours. In **Term 2**, CCAs have started in **Week 1** on **24 Mar (Tue)**. More information has been provided to students by their CCA teachers.

3. Enrichment and Remedial Programme (ERP)

The Primary 4 ERP is conducted for selected students after school hours from **Term 2 Week 1**. Consent forms have been issued to the selected students by the respective teachers-in-

5. International Friendship Day and Career Awareness Week

The school will be commemorating International Friendship Day (IFD) on **6 Apr (Mon)**. The IFD theme is Singapore: Forging Friendships in a Complex World. International cooperation remains vital for us to address global issues collectively and seize new opportunities. By fostering an appreciation of different cultures and perspectives, Marsilians will be better equipped to contribute to a cohesive and globally connected society. Our youth can forge meaningful connections with our neighbours and help Singapore remain relevant in a complex world. In addition, they can embrace openness and opportunities for international cooperation, while deepening their understanding of Singapore's geopolitical realities and national interests.

In conjunction with this, elements of Education and Career Guidance (ECG) will also be incorporated throughout the week. Marsilians will have opportunities to participate in booth activities designed to create awareness of different careers and pathways, and to help them make connections between their interests, aspirations, and the world around them.

All Marsilians will come to school in their school uniform or PE attire as per normal. Various programmes will be planned to help them learn about and appreciate the diverse cultures in our cosmopolitan Singapore.

6. Green Citizenship @ MPS – Earth Week

As we approach Earth Day on 22 Apr, the school will be commemorating Earth Week in **Term 2 Week 4, from 13 Apr to 17 Apr**. In alignment with the global Earth Day theme, "Our Power, Our Planet," Green Citizenship @ MPS programmes will be organised to prepare Marsilians to adopt sustainable environmental practices, deepen their understanding of sustainability, and develop greater awareness of how their actions impact the environment.

Through these programmes, Marsilians will be equipped with the knowledge and skills to become active green citizens. By fostering a sense of responsibility and agency towards environmental issues, we hope to nurture environmentally conscious individuals and future leaders.

The theme "Our Power, Our Planet" emphasises the importance of renewable energy and calls for the tripling of global renewable energy generation by 2030. During Earth Week, Marsilians will be encouraged to take simple but meaningful actions such as saving electricity,

reducing waste, and practising responsible consumption, as a way of preparing to celebrate and contribute to Earth Day.

7. Primary 4 Connect@MPS

As part of our ongoing efforts to engage with stakeholders and provide parents with a better understanding of their child's educational journey, the school will host a workshop for Primary 4 parents on Science on **21 Apr (Tue)**.

The Science workshop will offer strategies for fostering a love of Science and deepening their understanding of scientific concepts. Additionally, a briefing on Subject-based Banding (SBB) will also be provided. All Primary 4 students will undergo SBB at the end of this academic year. SBB offers greater flexibility by allowing students to take a mix of Standard and Foundation subjects based on their strengths. This will enable your child to excel in areas where they are strong while reinforcing foundational skills in subjects requiring more support. More details about this event will be made available at a later date.

8. Primary 4 Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC)

The Primary 4 Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) will be held in **Term 2 Week 10**, on **28 May (Thu)** and **29 May (Fri)**. PCTC is an opportunity for parents, students and teachers to interact and dialogue about the student's progress through the course of Semester 1. More details about this event will be made available at a later date.
