Dear Parents,

Re: 2026 Primary 6 Calendar of Events for Term 3

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participating in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 6 level in Term 3.

1. Revision of Class Timetable

Your child would have received a new class timetable for **Term 3**, and it has taken effect in **Week 1** on **30 Jun (Tue)**. Please note that the change in timetable is to accommodate student programmes and staff movements.

2. Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

To better support our graduating cohort in their preparation for the PSLE, CCAs will be suspended for all Primary 6 students until the PSLE period is over. This arrangement will provide students with more time to focus on their academic revision and manage their well-being during this crucial period.

3. Enrichment and Remedial Programme (ERP)

The Primary 6 ERP is conducted for **all** students, unless otherwise stated, after school hours from **Term 3 Week 1**. The Primary 6 September ACE Programme will be conducted during the September school holidays. Details are listed in the table below.

Note: There are no school-based activities arranged on Tuesdays and Fridays during the school term, unless informed otherwise.

4. Morning Lectures

Bite-sized morning lectures for English Language, Mathematics, and Science will be conducted on Thursdays and Fridays for Primary 6 students who arrive in school early. These sessions are designed to address common misconceptions, reinforce key concepts, and equip students with subject-specific examination skills and strategies.

Students from previous Primary 6 cohorts have found these lectures useful in strengthening their understanding and building their confidence in preparation for the examinations. More information will be provided by the respective subject teachers.

5. Direct School Admission for Secondary Schools (DSA-Sec)

Secondary schools will shortlist and select students who have applied to their schools through the Direct School Admission for Secondary Schools (DSA-Sec) between **29 Jun (Mon) and 28 Aug (Fri)**. DSA-Sec schools may conduct selection activities, such as interviews, auditions or trials, for the various DSA talent areas.

As the selection process and timeline differ across schools and DSA-Sec categories, parents are encouraged to refer to MOE's DSA-Sec website (<https://www.moe.gov.sg/secondary/dsa>) and the respective secondary schools' websites for more details on the interview and selection process. Parents are also strongly encouraged to inform their child's Form Teachers of the interview, audition or trial details so that the school can advise accordingly.

6. Personal Grooming and Attire Check

Marsilians are expected to always be good ambassadors of the school by maintaining a neat and tidy appearance. Having proper attire and grooming also shows readiness for learning. The school will conduct a personal grooming and attire check in **Term 3 Week 5**. Marsilians should refer to the Student Handbook (pg. 20 to 23) for more information on school's expectations for personal grooming and attire.

7. Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight

The school will conduct Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight in **Term 3 Week 2 and 3**. This annual event is dedicated to creating a conducive environment for promoting the use and learning of MTLs beyond the classroom and school setting. This year's theme is **Celebrate Our Languages; Embrace Our Heritage**. Through a variety of engaging activities related to the different MTLs, the school aims to encourage students to appreciate the beauty of their MTLs while deepening their understanding of the rich cultures and traditions that shape their identities. Through fun and meaningful activities, students will develop pride in their heritage and strengthen their connection to their roots.

8. Primary 6 Preliminary Oral Examinations

The Primary 6 Preliminary Oral Examinations will be held in **Term 3 Week 3** on **15 Jul (Wed) and 16 Jul (Thu)**. To simulate the PSLE Oral Examinations conditions, **all Primary 6 students** are required to report to school on these two days.

Primary 1 and Primary 2 students will also report to school as usual for lessons. **Primary 3 to Primary 5 students** are not required to attend school, they will be on Home-based Learning (HBL) and are to complete their assigned work at home.

9. Racial Harmony Day

The school will commemorate Racial Harmony Day in **Term 3 Week 4**. This year's theme is **Our People, Our Tapestry** which reflects how our diverse cultural identities and traditions are intertwined. Through understanding and respect for all communities, we maintain a strong, unified multicultural society that celebrates our shared heritage. Students will participate in engaging activities to discover and appreciate different cultures. They will also explore how various ethnic groups contribute to protecting our common spaces, strengthening trust and fostering friendships where every individual's experiences enrich our diverse community.

10. Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM)@MPS

The school will conduct Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM)@MPS Week in **Term 3 Week 5**. This year, students are invited to embark on **Mission: Sky to Space**, where they will explore STEAM through the exciting worlds of air and space travel. Through engaging in-class lessons, recess activities and assembly programmes, students will investigate how things fly, travel and move beyond Earth, while developing critical thinking, collaboration and innovation. This theme aims to make STEAM learning fun, meaningful and inspiring as students imagine, design and discover new possibilities from the skies to space.

11. National Day

The school will celebrate National Day in **Term 3 Week 6** on **7 Aug (Fri)**. Students will be dismissed early at 10.30 a.m. on that day. They may report to school in their school PE shirt or a red-coloured T-shirt without offensive prints or logos, paired with their school PE shorts for the celebration. They are also encouraged to bring some healthy snacks for their Take 10!

12. Primary 6 PSLE Oral Examinations

The Primary 6 PSLE Oral Examinations will be held in **Term 3 Week 7** on **12 Aug (Wed) and 13 Aug (Thu)**. Only Primary 6 students are required to report to school on these two days. **Primary 1 to Primary 5 students** are not required to attend school, they will be on Home-based Learning (HBL) and are to complete their assigned work at home.

13. Teachers' Day Celebration

The school will celebrate Teachers' Day in **Term 3 Week 10** on **3 Sep (Thu)**. Students will be dismissed early at 10.30 a.m. on that day. The Teachers' Day activities planned for students aim to provide them with opportunities to express their appreciation and gratitude to their

teachers for their dedication, care, and contributions throughout the year. We look forward to a meaningful celebration with the students.
