1. Enrichment and Remediation Programme (ERP)

8. Post-PSLE Programmes

The school has planned a variety of level-wide programmes to be carried out after PSLE to develop our P6 Marsilians in the Physical, Intellectual, Emotional and Social domains (PIES). These programmes include:

- ECG Workshops Secondary School Publicity Talk series and school visits to help students learn more about secondary school life and make informed decisions about their secondary school selection
- Code For Fun Enrichment programme to increase students' knowledge of computational thinking, coding and making
- Hip Hop Dance Clinic Enrichment programme to develop students' self-confidence, team spirit, sense of rhythm in music, and understanding of simple body alignment and coordination
- Values Project 'Giving-back' movement to help graduating classes to learn about their roles in imparting school values to the student population, and to understand more about selected Southeast Asian countries
