
Learning of Mother Tongue Language in a glance


MT language learning caters to a wider range of students with different starting point and it aims to help each student to attain the highest proficiency in MTL as he or she can.

The learning of Chinese language follows a thematic-based approach. All students will take the core module and students who requires more support can take the bridging modules. Those who showed more interest and ability in CL will take enrichment modules that are offered in primary 5 and 6 as Higher Mother Tongue.

To foster students' interest in the language, various strategies including story-telling, role-playing and hands on activities are used in class. These experiences make language learning interesting and relevant to daily life. Chinese language programmes are planned to make sure students are given real life experiences of using the language.




The vision of 'Arif Budiman' is to develop students as active and proficient user of Malay Language (ML) and has deep appreciation of Malay culture as part of the multi-racial community in Singapore.

The ML syllabus focuses on listening, speaking, reading, writing, interactive speaking and interactive writing skills. These skills are explicitly taught so that students are able to communicate and interact effectively with confidence.

Teachers use differentiated instruction to cater to a wider range of ability and the different learning profiles in class.

The learning process is carefully designed to equip students with essential knowledge and skills that will make them become competent users of ML.





The objective of the TL Syllabus is to develop students to be confident and effective communicators in both verbal and written Tamil. To achieve this, students are taught listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in an engaging and creative manner.

Mother Tongue Reading Programme

The objective of the MT Reading programme is to instil the love for reading in Marsilians. This programme comprises of

- **E-Zhishi**, a Chinese bi-weekly magazine as a supplementary reading materials. E- Zhishi provides a vivid and engaging experience of learning Chinese language.
- **Moo-O** helps P2 students to master the fluency of reading and speaking skills by turning them into the story character.
- The Mother Tongue department also provides for students of all level reading materials as **class library**. Students build their reading portfolio by recording the titles, their reviews and reflection of the stories, character and etc.
- Pre-assembly Silent Reading Time is a protected time for students to read MT storybook on every Friday.

Festival celebrations and External Language Competitions

Students will be further exposed to Chinese, Malay and Tamil Language and culture through festival celebrations.

Students are also encouraged to participate in external language competitions to further support their mastery of the language and to grant them the opportunities to learn from their peers from other schools
